In 2009 ETSC launched a project Preventing Road Accidents and Injuries for the Safety of Employees (PRAISE) to increase road safety in the work context. The project is co-funded by the European Commission, the Fundació MAPFRE, the German Road Safety Council (DVR) and the Swiss Council for Accident Prevention (bfu). It aims to “praise” best practices in order to help employers secure high road safety standards for their employees.
