Whiplash injuries, also called whiplash associated disorders, resulting from car accidents are an increasing problem to European society. Whiplash is the most commonly reported injury in motor vehicle crashes and presents a high cost burden to the society in general. Whiplash injuries often occur with a rear impact, when the head is first pushed backwards and then forwards. Yearly more than a million European citizens suffer neck injuries from rear-end collisions. Whiplash injuries are estimated to cost the European society up to 10 billion euros per year. Whiplash injuries are usually not life threatening but are one of the most important injury categories in terms of long-term consequences.

This ETSC Transport Safety Lunch brings together international experts from different sectors to focus on whiplash protection for Europe.

- What are whiplash injuries and how do they occur?
- Why are whiplash injuries an increasing social and financial problem?
- What vehicle safety factors can have an influence on the occurrence of whiplash injuries?
- Do we need EU wide standard crash test procedures on whiplash protection?
- What can the European Commission do to promote whiplash protection systems?

ETSC invites you to discuss these and other questions at a Transport Safety Lunch in Brussels. During this event, we will also launch a new ETSC policy paper on whiplash protection in Europe.
