



**Invitation ETSC Lunch on High Risk Sites Treatment
And the Roads to Respect 'R2R' Award Ceremony**

On Wednesday the 1st of October 2008 ETSC will hold its Lunch on High Risk Sites treatment in Square de Meûs 38/40 close to the European Parliament. This event will also host the Roads to Respect (R2R) Award Ceremony.

Road safety research shows that safer road design and layout would do most to reduce the rate of death and serious injury. In particular, treating high risk infrastructure sites is an area of road safety work where very substantial and sustainable casualty reductions can be achieved in relatively short time and at relatively low costs. This Lunch will be an opportunity to hear qualified speakers on the importance of best practices in safe road engineering and recent advancements in the field.

R2R is a paneuropean campaign for better road engineering run by ETSC that focuses on the treatment of high risk road sites. Throughout a year and a half, dedicated students from Italy, Spain, and Poland who enrolled in ETSC's R2R programme have lobbied their local authorities extensively to fix a high risk road site that they have identified and proposed low cost, easy to implement, road engineering measures.

The ETSC lunch will host the R2R Award Ceremony that will reward the efforts of the students who have obtained the best results throughout this programme.
