In 2009 ETSC launched a new project Preventing Road Accidents and Injuries for the Safety of Employees (PRAISE) to increase road safety in the work context. The project is co-funded by the European Commission, Fundación MAPFRE, the German Road Safety Council (DVR) and the Swiss Council for Accident Prevention (bfu). It aims to “praise” best practices in order to help employers secure high road safety standards for their employees. In the framework of this campaign, ETSC is organising a series of seminars in selected Member States bringing together companies, fleet safety managers, government, and road safety experts.

Building on the success of the first Spanish PRAISE seminars held on 14th June 2010 in Barcelona, and on 9th June in Oviedo, ETSC is organising a follow-up seminar to promote best practices of companies in specific work related areas building on the PRAISE thematic reports. In co-operation with the Fundación MAPFRE, the Business to Business PRAISE seminar will be held on 23rd November in Madrid.
